On July 6th, at 6:00pm, the Flint Township Police began an investigation into a missing/ endangered Flint child; Londin Boyce Age 3.

Londin Boyce was last seen with her biological mother Nicole Sheree Cook, female black, DOB 9-8-1986.

Cook's parental rights were terminated by the 7th Circuit Court Family Division. The whereabouts of the child are unknown at this time but she is believed to possibly be headed to the Cleveland, OH area. Boyce and Cook were last seen on 6-4-11 at 3:00pm at the Sunridge Apartment Complex. Boyce was wearing a white and pink top, pink shorts and pink sandals.
